



VÍCTOR GONZÁLEZ (Jerez de la Frontera, Cádiz, 1996)

Víctor González holds a degree in Fine Arts from the University of Seville. He has lived and worked in Spain, Italy and the United Kingdom, where he has held exhibitions and developed different projects.

Víctor González's work intuitively explores the codes of representation of painting from the interpretation of cultural elements of his environment. Elements of diverse origins such as architecture, ornamental material or objects. A prism of his own, made up of forms and sensations that serve as a handle to pull a thread in which painting reveals itself. Compositions that propose biogeometrically assembled spaces and atmospheres in which the viewer's subconscious finishes constructing the pictorial image.

In addition to what we commonly know as format painting, his production includes other lines of work with which he explores pictorial language through other techniques and materials. A search for the internal language of painting, from outside of it.

His work has won grants and awards such as the VIII Certamen UNIA de Pintura de la Universidad Internacional de Andalucía, the Honourable Mention of the I Premio de Creación artística organised by the CICUS and the Diputación de Sevilla as well as the artistic residency of the Fundación Antonio Gala or the XIV Encontro de Artistas Novos of the Xunta de Galicia and Fundación Cidade da Cultura.

His work has recently been exhibited in institutions such as the Royal Academy in London, the DiGALLERY in Seville and the Fundación Unicaja in Seville, among others.
